WHY MAKE A WILL

Making a Will is one of the most important steps you can take to protect the people you care about and to ensure your wishes are followed after your death.

- If you have children under 18, a Will is the only way to formally appoint Guardians.



CASE STUDY | NO WILL, NO LEGACY

When David died suddenly at 58, he had no Will in place. He had two adult children, Emma and Jack from his first marriage and was married to Sarah at the time of his death, his second wife.

David had always told his children that they would “definitely get the house one day”. Emma & Jack assumed that their Dad had made the necessary arrangements and taken care of it. However, because David had not made a Will, his estate had to be distributed under the standard intestacy rules.

Under those rules, David’s estate was distributed in a way that did not likely reflect his wishes. His house and all of his savings went to his second wife, Sarah.

This led to tension and distress within the family at an already difficult time.

After David’s funeral, Emma and Jack never saw Sarah again. They believe their Dad wanted them to inherit but suspect he simply never got around to putting a Will in place and formalising his wishes.

– A simple Will could have protected David’s wishes and prevented this outcome, but without one, the law decided instead.

You will also receive a brochure with all the key information you need ahead of your consultation.

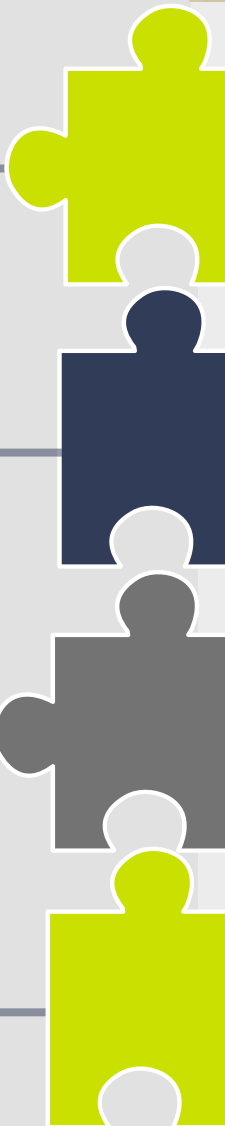
Your appointment will usually take up to 60 minutes, and if your situation is more complex or you require additional planning, a further appointment may be arranged to ensure everything is set up properly for you.

Yes, absolutely!

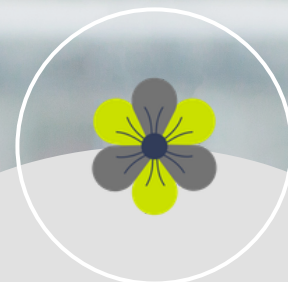
We highly recommend that you include your partner in the process. This should be a team effort. Your partner will be entitled to the same benefits that you have!

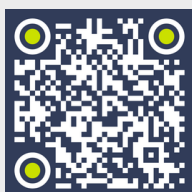
